



# LITHIUM-ION BATTERY AIR TRANSPORTATION RULES

## PASSENGER AIRCRAFT- CHECK-IN & CARRY-ON BAGGAGE



	<p>CARRY-ON BAGGAGE</p>		<p>You may carry-on HEDBOX Li-Ion Batteries that are rated between 100Wh~160Wh as long as they are installed on/in electronic device</p>		<p>Spare batteries not installed on/in an electronic device are limited to carry-on max 2 (two) unit/peaces per person.</p>	
	<p>CARRY-ON BAGGAGE</p>		<p>You may carry-on unlimited HEDBOX Li-Ion Batteries that are equal to or less than 100Wh</p>		<p>Spare batteries not installed on/in an electronic device are required to be packed in a protective pouch or bag.</p>	
	<p>CHECK-IN BAGGAGE</p>		<p>You may check-in HEDBOX Li-Ion Batteries that are equal to or less than 160 Wh as long as they are installed on/in electronic device.</p>		<p>Spare batteries are not allowed to be checked-in, not in the baggage, nor in the box, nor like separate as alone.</p>	

Please confirm with your airline carrier to determine any local rules and policies before traveling. Equipment must be a personal electronic and/or mobile device, only spare batteries must be safely transported and individually protected to prevent short circuiting. Place the battery in the original HEDBOX packaging, plastic bag or protective pouch-packaging that completely encloses the battery. Exposed terminals must be covered with tape or a protective cover. **Passengers cannot check-in baggage, that contain any spare batteries, regardless of the battery watt-hour (Wh) rating.**
